Is Holy Ghost Your Friend?

A Message from Bishop Wellington Boone

Many Christians know that the Holy Ghost has power. They know He provides gifts of the Spirit and fruit of the Spirit. They would be able to say that Holy Ghost does the Father's will just as Jesus does the Father's will.

However, when I wrote a book called *Holy Ghost Is My Friend*, this idea of Friendship with the Holy Ghost was another matter!

The message for this year of 2012 is how to cultivate an airtight relationship with the eternal God through Friendship with the Holy Ghost. Even if you have read what Jesus said in John 14 and 15 about the Comforter, you have probably not considered the implications that you are now not only Jesus' Friend but also a friend of the Great Holy Ghost Who created the world.

Throughout this *Year of the Holy Ghost Bible Reading Guide* I have noted some of the crucial places where Holy Ghost was there. He is everywhere throughout the Bible, but certain places need to be highlighted so He will not be missed or ignored. You will want to mark more for yourself as you read.

Remember—He was there at creation. He was active in every aspect of Jesus' life—conception, baptism, anointing and public call to ministry. He led Jesus into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil, raised Jesus from the dead, came to the disciples at Pentecost with the Baptism in the Holy Ghost (the promise of the Father). The Acts of the Apostles are the Acts of the Holy Ghost!

Ever since Adam, Christians have been the hope of creation. What the first Adam lost, the Last Adam, Christ, restored and presented to you, if you are born again. As a Christian, you can have an impact that is impossible for you to measure. You can bring healing to others through your Friendship with Holy Ghost. God's abundant life through Jesus Christ can be yours and abundant life can be restored to earth—through you.

Two steps you can take

1. Set a specific time to meet with your Friend every day. Tell Him, "This is my time between You and me." Don't start with a commitment you can't keep. Choose something where you know you can be faithful and then move toward spending more time together. During this time read through the Bible and pray and also set aside time just to be quiet and listen. You can't be a friend if you do all the talking. This Friend has a lot to say to you.
2. Ask Holy Ghost to help you to do something you have never done. This will be your adventure into the supernatural dimension where He lives.

READING THROUGH THE BIBLE IN ONE YEAR

Start reading today! Although this is a dated reading guide, not everyone will be able to start this guide on January 1. Whenever you begin, simply find that date and start there. In that way, all of us will be reading the same chapters of the Bible together on the same days of the year. At the end of the year, keep reading until you have completed the entire Bible in one year.

The Bible contains 1,189 chapters (Old Testament, 929 chapters; New Testament, 260 chapters). Reading 4 chapters per day, and repeating Proverbs and the End Times books of Daniel and Revelation, you can read every chapter in the entire Bible in 12 months.

EIGHT DIVISIONS OF THE BIBLE USED IN THIS READING GUIDE

Pentateuch. Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy

History. Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, 1 Kings, 2 Kings, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther (*1 and 2 Chronicles are read at the end of the Epistles. Acts is read after the Gospels.*)

Poetry. Job, Psalms, Song of Solomon (*Ecclesiastes is read at the end of the Prophets.*)

Wisdom. Proverbs (*repeated during the year*)

Prophets. Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi (*Isaiah is read after the Gospels and Acts.*)

Gospels. Matthew, Mark, Luke, John (*followed by Acts and Isaiah*)

Epistles. Romans, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 Thessalonians, 2 Thessalonians, 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Hebrews, James, 1 Peter, 2 Peter, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John, Jude (*followed by 1 and 2 Chronicles*)

End Times. Daniel, Revelation (*repeated during the year*)

My Friend Holy Ghost was with the apostles in the New Testament and also with the patriarchs and major and minor prophets in the Old Testament. As He revealed the reality of God to them, their ability became more about what God was about than what they were about. Their priorities, their destiny, and the way they lived pointed to God as the explanation.

Notice our Friend Holy Ghost as you read through the Bible this year and ask yourself these questions:

1. Where is He found in Scripture?
2. What is He doing there?
3. What is the result of His being there?
4. What does it mean to us today?

In February, you will read about the gifts of the Holy Ghost that Paul described in 1 Corinthians Chapter 12: word of wisdom, word of knowledge, faith, healing, working of miracles, prophecy, discerning of spirits, speaking in unknown tongues, interpretation of tongues.⁶

All four Gospels speak of Jesus as the baptizer in the Holy Ghost. When you are baptized in the Holy Ghost, you are immersed in Him. You are lost in Him. Your deeds are His deeds. Your thoughts and words come from Him. Your greatest goal is to obey Jesus, think like Him, and become like Him.

The Baptism in the Holy Ghost is a gateway into your relationship with our Friend, Holy Ghost after you are born again and receive Jesus as your Savior and Lord.

It is not the relationship, but it is the door you enter to Holy Ghost Friendship.

In March, you will read in the Gospel of Mark how John the Baptist prophesied that just as people were immersed in water in his baptism, they would be immersed in the Holy Ghost in Jesus’ Baptism.

“I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit!”⁷

The Greek word for baptize is *baptizo* [pronounced bap-tid'-zo] meaning to immerse, submerge, or make fully wet. It is a derivative of *bapto* [pronounced bap'-to'] that means “to overwhelm, i.e. cover wholly with a fluid . . . (by implication) to stain (as with dye); dip.”⁸

ANOINTING YOURSELF WITH OIL DAILY—THE EIGHTFOLD ANOINTING

Excerpted from *Holy Ghost Is My Friend* by Wellington Boone¹⁶

Several years ago I looked in the mirror and asked myself, “Do you understand that you must have the right attitude to approach Someone as great as God?”

When I am making contact with God, is Jesus’ blood sufficient or could God destroy me in a moment for approaching Him in the wrong way as He did in the Old Testament to those who displeased Him?

Do I appreciate when I am praying that all of His resources are released to bring to pass again what Jesus began to accomplish on the earth?

Anointing Yourself to Pray

Prayer is a ministry of the Holy Ghost where divine business is transacted in the name of Jesus. The name of Jesus is so powerful that someday every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord.¹⁷

I considered that since divine business is being transacted when God is moving, would God move for someone like me? God wants to work on my behalf but does God have to work against me because I am out of line? Is God serious while I am just religious?

In that mirror I had a little glimpse of reality. He didn’t have to talk to me. He could choose not to. I knew it was serious right then and there. For a second the fear of God came on me. I said I don’t want to be perfunctory about this. I need to be more holy.

From then on, I implemented by the Holy Ghost certain practices including a daily anointing of myself. Every day I anoint myself with oil and consecrate myself to serve the Lord. I want to share this revelation with you.

Anointed for a Sweet Aroma from Your Life

The mark of a Christian is to bring “the sweet savor,”¹⁸ or the essence, of Jesus Christ wherever we go. When Mary anointed Jesus feet,¹⁹ He said that she was anointing Him for His death. Ingredients in her aromatic anointing oil had been crushed to bring forth the odor of sweet perfume.

If you let Holy Ghost crush you and break you down so that you get lost in Christ, a sweet aroma will come out of your life through that voluntary humiliation. You will create the aroma of heaven on earth with your Christ-like attitudes.

“But thank God! He has made us his captives and continues to lead us along in Christ’s triumphal procession. Now he uses us to spread the knowledge of Christ everywhere, like a sweet perfume. Our lives are a Christ-like fragrance rising up to God. But this fragrance is perceived differently by those who are being saved and by those who are perishing. To those who are perishing, we are a dreadful smell of death and doom. But to those who are being saved, we are a life-giving perfume.”²⁰

Anointed to Die to Your Self-Will

“If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.”²¹

Dying to your flesh means that you don't want your own way. You have come to the place where you say as Jesus did in Gethsemane, "Not my will but Thy will be done, Father."²² Your problem with fulfilling your anointing isn't primarily the devil. Your problem is your pride and self-will.

When I hear preachers and singers say they are anointed, I wonder if they realize that my Friend, Holy Ghost, Who does the anointing, wants them dead! Paul said:

*"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me."*²³

Before you are anointed like Jesus, you have to die to your flesh so that Jesus can come alive in you. You want your Friend Holy Ghost working in you at a higher level and you want Him to come to stay until you are finished on earth.

Anointing Yourself for Supernatural Power

When Jesus said, "*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because He hath anointed me,*"²⁴ the word "anointing" in Greek also means to smear. When you smear yourself daily with anointing oil it reminds you of the supernatural power of God within you. God is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we can ask or think by the power that is at work within you.²⁵ The anointing represents what is happening to your spirit through Holy Ghost. This is a natural picture of a spiritual reality that is already true in heaven.

*"Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us."*²⁶

Anoint yourself as a reminder that God said He would dwell in you. Your body is "*this dwelling where God lives by his Spirit.*"²⁷ There is no telling what God might do through your life. You want every part anointed so that God can sanctify and use you. You anoint yourself daily because you are totally given over to your Friend, Holy Ghost.

Anointing Yourself to Carry an Aroma of Holiness

The ingredients of the holy anointing oil were aromatic. The people could tell when Aaron and his sons had been anointed. So I anoint myself every day with a mixture of oil and my cologne as a reminder that the Bible says our lives have an aroma. To some who are not Christian, it smells like a deadly venom and they hate you, as they hated Jesus. To others on the pathway of Christ, your life is a sweet smelling aroma.

Your life is emitting some kind of odor. It is saying something to people who either love being around you or would rather not be around you because you have become a reminder of what they are not living.

Your Personal Eightfold Anointing

When Gabriel, the angel of the Lord, appeared to Mary, he spoke to her what the Lord had said concerning the Child Jesus Who was to come. Mary responded, "*Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word.*"²⁸

Mary had a hearing ear that was the key to her obedience. She became pregnant with a revelation from God. Jesus came not through human intercourse but through spiritual intercourse. The womb of her spirit was in her ears.

In the womb of a woman, the Church, God wants to conceive children. The spiritual babies of God are conceived when God comes with a word and you have hearing ears. You become impregnated with a vision for evangelism through your ears. You hear the Word of the Lord and you obey.

The reason that many of us are not pregnant with the blessings of God is that we have been hearing things that bring curses instead of blessings. The devil uses the same ear-gate as the Lord. When you listen to music or movies that are full of cursing and ungodly sex, the devil is sowing into you seeds of death and curses. You are a product of what you let into your ear-gate. How can you become like God when TV is the prophet that speaks to your spirit?

Eight is the number for new beginnings and rebirth. Here are eight parts of your body to anoint daily:

- Head
- Body
- Ears
- Eyes
- Nose
- Mouth
- Feet
- Hands

Below are statements that you can declare as you anoint each part and Scriptures to validate these declarations.

Eightfold Anointing—Head

I anoint my head so that I will have the mind of Christ,²⁹ that I will mind spiritual things,³⁰ that I will be transformed by the renewing of my mind,³¹ that my thoughts will be His thoughts and my ways will be His ways.³²

Eightfold Anointing—Body

I anoint my body, which is the temple of the Holy Spirit, for I am not my own. I was bought with a price. Therefore I will glorify God in my body and in my spirit, which are God's.³³ My flesh will be dead to sin—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life.³⁴ I will fast and live a fasted lifestyle.³⁵

Eightfold Anointing—Ears

I anoint my ears to hear the voice of God.³⁶ My ear is the womb of my spirit where God is speaking to me to conceive vision.³⁷ I will become pregnant with the revelation of God. I will never refuse to hear what is right. I will always hear what the Spirit says.³⁸ In the midst of criticism and condemnation, I will hear only who I am in Christ.³⁹

Eightfold Anointing—Eyes

I anoint my eyes so that God will open my eyes that I might see. I will focus on what God is doing so that He can take me beyond myself and my circumstances. I anoint my eyes to see Jesus,⁴⁰ to see visions from God,⁴¹ to see which spirit comes from God.⁴² I anoint my eyes to see how Jesus looks at me.⁴³ I will not be distracted by what others see but only what God sees for my life.

Eightfold Anointing—Nose

I anoint my nose so that I will have discernment, wisdom, and judgment in my relationships with others and know what is right before the Lord. Christ is made unto me wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption.⁴⁴ If I lack wisdom, I will receive it from the Lord.⁴⁵

Eightfold Anointing—Mouth

I anoint my mouth for words of life, because death and life are in the power of the tongue.⁴⁶ With my mouth I shall decree a thing, and it shall be established.⁴⁷ I will speak no idle words, because Jesus said by my words I will be justified and by my words I will be condemned.⁴⁸ I anoint myself so that my words will be acceptable to God.⁴⁹ That they will bless and not curse. That I will represent Jesus in what I say, but never *misrepresent* Him.⁵⁰ That I will speak the Word and live the Word that I speak.⁵¹ That I will pray continually,⁵² so that His presence will be always with me.⁵³

Eightfold Anointing—Feet

I anoint my feet that I might walk in the Spirit and not in the flesh.⁵⁴ I will walk in His footsteps.⁵⁵ I will walk with the weight of glory in my life,⁵⁶ so that my footsteps might leave an imprint that the generation can follow. I anoint my feet that my walk might be pleasing to God,⁵⁷ in lowliness and meekness,⁵⁸ that my life might be modeled after,⁵⁹ that I would not walk in any place or destiny that is not ordained for me. That my walk and my lifestyle would take me into His perfect will forever.⁶⁰

Eightfold Anointing—Hands

I anoint my hands to lay hands on people to bless them.⁶¹ To lay hands on the sick and they will recover.⁶² To anoint kings⁶³ and the five-fold ministry⁶⁴ into office—apostle, prophet, pastor, teacher, and evangelist. To work the works of Him that sent me, while it is day, because when the night comes, no man can work.⁶⁵ That my work will bear fruit into eternity.⁶⁶

When I complete my anointing, I say . . .

I am anointed today to serve God and man, and to represent Jesus to the world! “This is the day which the Lord has made. I will rejoice and be glad in it!”⁶⁷

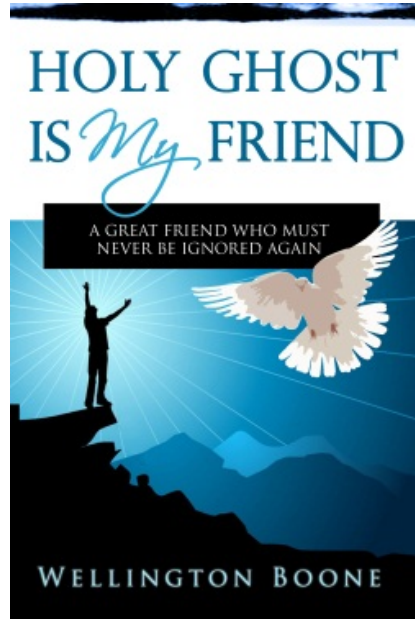
